



Day 02 – Guided city tour of Melbourne, including a visit to the Melbourne Cricket ground (subject to availability and no matches being played during the time of visit)

After a buffet breakfast in your hotel, proceed on a guided city tour of Melbourne. Visit the famous and beautiful Royal Botanical Gardens, Town Hall, St. Patrick’s Cathedral, National Tennis center, the 1956 Olympic venue, the Shrine of Remembrance, Bourke Street Mall and some beautifully-restored Victorian houses. Also, visit the **Melbourne Cricket ground**, which gives the visitors the opportunity to relive their great sporting memories through a comprehensive tour of this marvellous stadium, where so many champions of yesterday and today have performed.

Day 03 – full day trip to Great Ocean Road without doubt the most scenic drives in Australia

After an early American breakfast at the hotel, get ready to spend the entire day at the Great Ocean Road. Enjoy the spectacular views over golden surf beaches, sheer cliff faces and magnificent stands of Eucalyptus. The Great Ocean Road hugs the coastline along the entire length of Port Campbell National Park. The coastline with its twisted shapes of amazing rock formation, the famous ‘Twelve Apostles’ – huge stone pillars rising from the surf, remnants of the London Bridge, a rocky promontory arch carved out by the continual force of the sea, the





Loch Ard Gorge (site of the dramatic shipwreck of the 'Loch Ard'— over 100 years ago), will give a photographer some spectacular pictures this evening. You can also **opt to** experience a once in a lifetime thrill of a scenic helicopter ride over Port Campbell.

Day 04 - Onto Phillip Island where an array of natural and man made attractions to visit as well as a host of activities that will keep you entertained for hours.

After breakfast proceed to the Phillip Island, which is approximately 3 hrs from Melbourne and is the home of the world famous Penguin Parade and the Australian MotoGP event.

The **Penguin Parade** is one of the most well known and popular of the attractions on Phillip Island. Each evening just after the sun sets (at dusk) the little penguins or better known as fairy penguins, stroll up the beach to after a period of time at sea to return to their burrows. The world's largest colony of Australian Fur Seal can be found on a rocky outcrop, known as Seal Rocks, about one kilometre from Phillip Island's coastline

Day 05 – Explore Phillip Island on your own— Visit the Grand Prix racing circuit, a chocolate factory and also Amaze N Things. Then drive back to Melbourne

After an American breakfast in your hotel, you can relax or explore Phillip Island **on your own**. Head to the Grand Prix racing circuit. This is where motorbike races and super championships are held. Next, visit the Amaze N Things with its giant maze, mini golf and indoor illusions centre. From here visit a small chocolate factory where you can see how chocolates are made and also buy some mouth watering chocolates.

Later drive back to Melbourne. The rest of the day is at leisure for you to do some shopping at one of the many beautiful shops.
